VICTORIA – BC Ferries is preparing for a busy Easter long weekend and has added 60 sailings during peak travel times between Vancouver and Vancouver Island on the Tsawwassen – Swartz Bay and the Departure Bay – Horseshoe Bay routes.

- 10 extra sailings are scheduled on the Departure Bay – Horseshoe Bay route

The most popular travel times are expected to be mid-day Thursday to late morning Friday, with traffic returning on the holiday Monday afternoon. BC Ferries reminds customers with reservations to inform the ticket agent that they have a reservation when they arrive at the ticket booth.
